






One day the Nabataeans discovered that people in the big cities wanted frankincense, which is a type of perfume. The Nabataeans knew that frankincense came from the countries of Yemen and Oman. They travelled to these countries by camel caravans.





Soon the Nabataeans needed to have a secret place in the desert where their families could live safely and where they could store the frankincense and other goods that their caravans were carrying. They decided to use caves in the rocks.




The Nabataeans created a secret city in the limestone mountains of Jordan. The entrance to the city was through a crack in the side of a mountain. This crack was 1.5 km long and over 90 meters (300 feet) high. They called their city Raqim, but later the Romans called it Petra.




As time passed, their empire grew and many Nabataean families became wealthy.


Their caves, which they used as warehouses, had beautifully carved designs.







The Nabataeans were famous for being able to catch and store almost every drop of rain. They brought water into their secret city in open channels carved into the rock and in clay pipes under the ground.



At one time the Roman army tried to find where the Nabataeans got their frankincense from. Their Nabataean guides led them along through the desert where most of the army died of thirst.







Eventually the Romans were successful in finding out that frankincense came from Yemen and they started taking it back to Rome by boat.



The painter has left without painting her pots. Can you finish the job for her? Luckily she's left some Nabataean designs for you to copy or, you could make up your own Nabataean designs.






There are four camels arriving in Petra, but which is which? Use the clues below to see if you can discover who is carryiying what in their caravan, and what color each person's camel bag is.



To Get You Started: Walu has the Yellow camel bag and is not carrying Frankincense.


#### **CLUES**

The Treasury: What was this building? perhaps a massive tomb for a Nabataean king, or a great library? Today it is still very impressive, but the carvings are very worn. See the man in the doorway? The building is huge!




One of the first tombs that you see as you come into Petra is the Obelisk Tomb. It is actually two tombs built on top of each other. The top tomb has four obelisks on the top of it. The bottom tomb is very badly worn by wind and sand.



The Urn tomb is found along one of the mountain walls in Petra. To get to the tomb you must climb up a long set of stairs. The Urn tomb had a large area in front of it where people could eat a last meal, to remember the person who was buried there.

If you look closely you still see Nabataean writing on the columns.



The largest tomb in Petra is the Monastery. See the man in the doorway? While this monument was originally built as a tomb it was later adopted as a monastery by Christian monks who lived in nearby mountain caves during the Middle Ages. It's a bit of a climb to get to it, but you can hire a donkey to ride on up the narrow cliff trail if you're brave enough!
